**Can I bring batteries with me

Overview

Can you carry a lithium battery with a power tool?

Lithium batteries installed in power tools can be packed in checked luggage, though spare lithium batteries must be carried on. Before traveling with your power tools, it's best to check with your airline and/or the TSA for up-to-date information on transporting them by plane.

Are power tool batteries allowed on a plane?

According to TSA and FAA guidelines, most power tool batteries are allowed in carry-on luggage, but not in checked bags, especially if they exceed 100 watt-hours (Wh). There are exceptions and rules around terminals being taped off, original packaging, and even how many batteries you can bring.

Are power tools allowed in checked luggage?

Gas and battery-powered tools are permitted in checked bags, but it's important to check gas-powered tools for residue, as this may be considered hazardous. Lithium batteries installed in power tools can be packed in checked luggage, though spare lithium batteries must be carried on.

Can you put power tools in a checked bag?

However, you can pack them in your checked bags as long as you follow a few rules, similar to what electronics can and can't be placed in checked bags. When the TSA refers to power tools, it's talking about drills and bits, too. The same is true for power tools with an installed battery.


