This report provides a budgetary analysis of The Gambia government's major development projects approved by Cabinet and the National Assembly for fiscal year 2024. Each development project was awarded and approved a budget of more than 500 million Dalasis to be spent in a single year. 1. Rice Value Chain IDB: D560 Million.

The Gambia's Electricity Sector Roadmap (2019-2025) aims to scale up electricity generation to 200 MW of available capacity at peak in 2025, with 14MW expected from the OMVG project with Guinea and Senegal, and 50MW from the Souapiti project and the remainder through Independent Power Producers (IPP).

Gambia Electricity Access Project(GEAP): D556.4 Million Project Operating Costs = D290.5 million [D278.2 million in project grants, expected from France; D12.3 million in project grants, expected from the African Development Bank (ADB)]. 
