A consistent and reliable power supply is paramount in our technology-driven era. An uninterruptible power supply, or UPS, ensures that our equipment and systems stay powered even in the face of electrical hiccups.

What should I do if my ups won't turn on?

- Refrain from placing heavy objects on the UPS. Protect it from physical damage by avoiding placing heavy items on top of it.
- Never plug the unit into itself. Doing this can cause power fluctuations, prompt the UPS to revert to battery power, cycle between the battery and normal operation, and spark inverter compatibility issues.

How does an ups work?

It consists of a battery, a charger, and an inverter. When the UPS is plugged into a wall outlet, it charges its battery, which is then used to provide backup power to the connected devices when the power goes out. Should You Turn off Your UPS When Not in Use?
