Overview

How many diesel buses will be delivered in Malaysia?

Finance Minister II Datuk Seri Amir Hamzah Azizan said the final acquisition of 310 diesel buses would be delivered from June, followed by 250 electric buses by year end.- NSTP/ AZIAH AZMEE KUALA LUMPUR: To improve public transport, RM1.9 billion has been allocated to buy new diesel and electric buses for the Klang Valley and Penang.

How many EV buses are being delivered in Malaysia?

As part of this initiative, 240 EV buses and 310 diesel buses are already being delivered, with another 1,100 buses arriving in stages. The introduction of EV buses aligns with Malaysia's push for greener and more sustainable public transport.

How many electric buses will Penang add in 2025?

The target: Add 1 138 electric buses between 2025 and 2030, in line with the National Energy Transition Roadmap (NETR). The Penang state government is progressively electrifying its fleet under its smart transport initiative, focusing on cleaner and more efficient solutions for urban routes.

When will electric buses be delivered in Malaysia?

The latest electric bus tender has closed and the appointment of contractors is expected soon. Delivery is targeted within 12 months of contract finalisation. In the time being, Malaysia is deploying 310 new Euro 5 diesel buses under the 2025 Bus Replacement Programme.
