Overview

How many new power plants will be installed in Mexico?

The grid upgrade will install new power plants in five states across Mexico. (Shutterstock) Mexico's Federal Electricity Commission (CFE) announced this week that it will invest US \$2.5 billion to develop five new power plants in the coming years.

What is the national power system in Mexico?

Mexico's National Power System (Sistema Eléctrico Nacional or SEN) is one of the largest in the Western Hemisphere. It is comprised of nine regions, plus a binational electricity system in Baja California. Most of the nine regions are interconnected, forming the National Interconnected System (Sistema Interconectado Nacional or SIN).

How many wind projects are planned in Mexico?

145 Transmission Projects Instructed to CFE. 80 projects to modernize the National Transmission Network (" RNT "). 65 projects scheduled from 2025 onwards to expand the RNT, with an estimated investment of 46.611 billion Mexican pesos. CFE Expansion Plan 2025-2030. 7 wind projects in 2027-2028: investment of 3.253 billion USD with 2,470 MW.

How much electricity does Mexico use in 2022?

According to Mexico's National Power System Development Program (Programa de Desarrollo del Sistema Eléctrico Nacional or PRODESEN), the electricity consumption of the National Electricity System was 333,662 GWh in 2022, which represented an annual increase of 3.4 percent.
