Overview

Will Dalia energy build a new power plant in Israel?

Dalia Energy has announced plans to build a new power plant in Ashdod, Israel. The project will cost 5.3 billion shekels (\$1.5 billion) and is being financed by Bank Hapoalim. The plant, called “Avshal,” will be constructed on the site of the current Eshkol power station. It will have a capacity of 850 megawatts.

What is a solar thermal power station in the Negev desert?

The Ashalim Solar Thermal Power Station in the Negev Desert combines photovoltaic and concentrated solar power technologies. It has an installed capacity of approximately 121 megawatts, contributing to Israel’s solar energy goals.

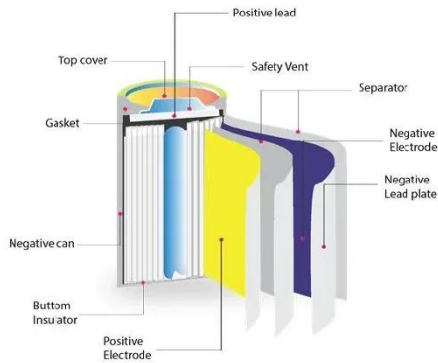
Should Israel continue using the reading power plant in Tel Aviv?

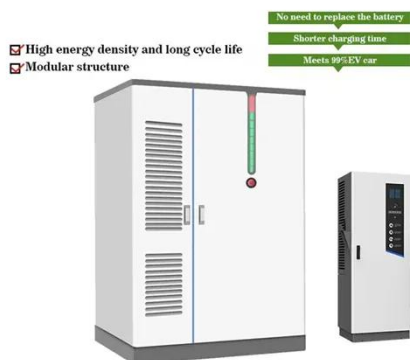

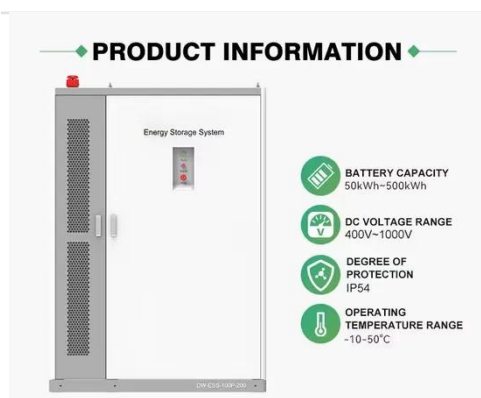
